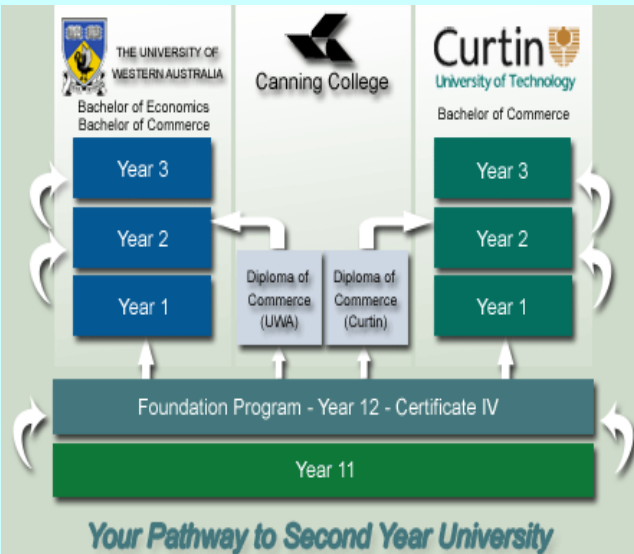
Ms Maya Jere has joined Canning's international team. She is originally from Zambia and came to Perth as an international student in 2004. She is a Curtin graduate.

CERTIFICATE AND DIPLOMA OF COMMERCE PATHWAYS



Entry into the **Certificate IV** is from the equivalent to Year 11 such as SMA 2—Indonesia, HKCEE—Hong Kong, SPM—Malaysia, O Levels—Singapore, SM 2 Chinese schools or equivalents. The Certificate IV is a single semester course leading to Diploma of Commerce or direct entry into certain first year courses at Curtin, Murdoch or ECU.

As can be seen from the diagram, Canning offers its students **choices, guaranteed pathways and safety nets.**

Choices: access to year 2 B.Com or B.Econs at Curtin and UWA. Results are also accepted by other WA and interstate universities.

Guarantees: students meeting the Curtin or UWA requirements are guaranteed a place in second year at the relevant university. Guaranteed places are also associated with WAUF Program and Certificate IV course.

Safety nets: if a student does not meet requirements for a high level course, then, the choice is available to take an alternative pathway.

Diploma of Commerce: UWA Stream and Curtin Stream. Entry is from the equivalent of Year 12 such as A Levels, STPM, SMA 3, HKALE, SM 3, IB—AS Levels are also considered. Successful completion provides a guaranteed place in year 2 at UWA or Curtin B.Com or B.Econ.
