### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM IMMIGRATION

This information applies mainly to students (and agents) where the Assessment Levels for a university course are higher than for Year 12 or Foundation as offered by Canning.

Examples:

Kenya: Canning Foundation is AL 2 ..... University courses are AL 3

India: Canning Foundation is AL 2 ..... University courses are AL 4

Zimbabwe: as above

" students can lodge subsequent student visa here in A/a rather than returning home to apply despite the change in the assessment level from 571 to 573. It will mean the student will have greater checks and hurdles to be granted the visa but is certainly able to apply for another student visa onshore in A/a (either paper or on-line application)."
